Aerial Work Platforms - There are a variety of forklift attachments existing on the market. They could help transform your forklift so that you can expand your ability to pick stuff up or accomplish clean up tasks and material handling with less effort.

A lot of the attachments are specially designed so as to fit on the blades themselves. Blade extensions for instance, are used whenever you need much more blade length, that increases lifting capability. Blade extensions come in lengths ranging from 48-120 inches. Rounded or triangular accessories are one more type used if moving rolled material in order to ensure it does not roll off of the traditional flat blades.

Examples of lifting accessories comprise pivoting and telescoping boom or crane accessories. They could come in a number of various styles and are most often utilized for moving lumber, poles, metal bars and different sort of bulky things. Other accessories like different kinds of hooks and hook plates are available so as to lift stuff utilizing a sling or chain. Magnetic lifters and slab lifters are other objects that could be utilized with hook accessories. Slab lifters are specialized accessories that are used for carrying a variety of materials that are delivered in a sheet or slab format. Rug rams or carpet poles are other lifting tools that connect to your lift truck in order to make transferring rolls of carpet easier. The attachment connects onto the forklift's forks and has a pole that goes through the middle of the carpet roll.

There are several types of lift truck attachment used for facility maintenance such as snow forks. These industrial blades can be attached to front end loaders and meant for transferring materials like for instance mulch, snow as well as dirt. Other popular cleanup accessories include magnetic sweepers and standard sweepers. Standard sweepers comprise a broom which the lift truck forks connect onto for sweeping big spaces such as factory floors, parking lots and warehouse. The magnetic sweeper is the same except that it has a magnetic plate rather than bristles. The magnetic sweeper is used in areas where there is lots of metal fragments such as on shop floors for example. Sweepers have widths as much as sixty inches and this surface area makes clean up effortless and fast.

Material spreaders are other attachments utilized on lift trucks. These spreaders are helpful for a range of applications like spreading pellets, fertilizers, insecticides, seeds, ice melt and rock salt.

Another optional lifting accessory are work platforms. These could be used by lots of different companies daily. Platforms may vary in size from 36" x 36" to up to 60" x 60". A few units may be accessible and are capable of folding up and storing into a smaller place. Work platforms are designed to raise staff up to an overhead location with the use of the lift truck. Larger platform units have extra space for personnel in order to bring tools and other necessary things meant for the task. Often work platforms are made of steel or ploy material.
